# Georgia Figure Skating Club Skater of the Year calculation and point system As of January 15, 2020 

Skaters earn points for each Test Passed and each competition event.

Point Values for Tests:

## Multipliers:

Multipliers are used to give more credit for bigger groups, and also higher profile events. Since NonQualifying and Qualifying skaters are in separate categories there is not a multiplier for Qualifying Regionals. Only 1 multiplier is used for any event. A skater won't get to use a $5-8$ skater multiplier AND a non-qualifying Nationals multiplier. They would get to use the higher.

5-8 skaters in the event 2
9-12 skaters in the event 3
Showcase Nationals (Adult \& Youth) 3
Adult Qualifying Sectionals event 4
Adult Non-Qualifying Nationals event 3
Adult Championship event 5

Ties are broken by test points.
If test points are tied, the award goes to the skater with the highest points earned in a single event.

The points for each event (Freeskate, Spins, Compulsory Dance, Light Entertainment, etc) at each competition are computed (placement and any multipliers), and the top 3 event points are used for the Competition points for the skater. This is added to the total Test Points to calculate the total points for the skater for the year.

## Example Calculations:

Stephanie passes the Adult Bronze Freeskate Test (4 points)

And, her competition history is:

2013 Eastern Adult Sectionals:
Bronze Freeskate $-2^{\text {nd }} / 7-3$ pts * 2 ( $5-8$ skaters in event) $=6$ pts Bronze Dramatic $-2^{\text {nd }} / 7-3$ pts * 2 ( $5-8$ skaters in event) $=6$ pts

2013 US Adult Nationals:
Bronze Freeskate - $1^{\text {st }} / 7-4$ pts * 3 (NQ Nationals) $=12$ pts
Bronze Dramatic $-3^{\text {rd }} / 7-2$ pts * 2 (NQ Nationals) $=4$ pts

2013 Atlanta Open:
Bronze Dramatic Skate - $1^{\text {st }} / 4=4$ pts (no multiplier)
Bronze Freeskate $-3^{\text {rd }} / 4=2$ pts

2013 Peach Classic:
Bronze Freeskate $-1^{\text {st }} / 3=4$ pts
Bronze Light Entertainment $-1^{\text {st }} / 4=4$ pts

Her top 3 finishes are:

Adult Nationals:
Bronze Freeskate $-1^{\text {st }} / 7-4$ pts $* 3$ (NQ Nationals) $=12$ pts

Adult Sectionals:
Bronze Freeskate $-2^{\text {nd }} / 7-3$ pts * 2 ( $5-8$ skaters in event) $=6$ pts Bronze Dramatic $-2^{\text {nd }} / 7-3$ pts $* 2$ ( $5-8$ skaters in event) $=6$ pts

So, that would be 24 points for competitions, and 4 points for tests $=28$ points total for the year.
