I. General Information

Eligibility: All competitors must be either: 1) a member in good standing of a club having membership in U.S. Figure Skating; 2) an individual member of U.S. Figure Skating; 3) a member of a national figure skating association that is a member of the ISU. Entries from members of clubs with a probationary status will be accepted provided the entry is accompanied by a signed certification by the skater that he or she is properly qualified to participate in the event(s) entered. Skaters may compete in as many disciplines as qualified by test level and age, but may compete in only one event per discipline; competitors may enter both team and solo dance events. Age and test qualifications as of July 21st, 2005 (close of entries), will determine classification.

All skaters must compete at their highest passed freestyle test, or one level higher. Pairs Freeskating competitors must meet the requirements listed in that section of this announcement.

Registration Desk: Will be open at the rink during the scheduled events. A tentative schedule will be posted at the rink. Skaters are required to check the official bulletin board at the rink for the scheduled events. The posting of such notices, changes or announcements shall be considered sufficient notice to competitors.

Schedule: Please include a self-addressed stamped envelope to receive a tentative schedule of events. A final schedule will be available at the registration desk, which will be open throughout the competition. **A schedule will be posted on the GaFSC web site at www.gafsc.org/peachclassic/ when available.**

Entries: Entries must be postmarked no later than July 21, 2005. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Committee and will require a late fee of \$25.00.

The Georgia Figure Skating Club reserves the right to divide or combine any event if necessary and to cancel any events (with full refund of entry fee.) Otherwise, refunds will be made only with a physician's note at the discretion of the Georgia Figure Skating Club. No refunds will be made because of competition cancellation due to acts of God.

Age Categories: The following age categories apply to all events:

Young Adult	18 to 20 years old
Class I	21 to 28 years old
Class II	29 to 35 years old
Class III	36 to 45 years old
Class IV	46 to 55 years old
Class V	56 years old & over

All age categories may be divided or combined depending on the number of registrations; there must be two (2) or more entries to hold an event. **Proof of age is required for all events.** Copy of birth certificate, passport, driver's license or similar proof of age is considered acceptable, but the Competition Committee reserves the right to require additional documentation.

*Note: The Young Adult age category applies to most events. However, in Dance competitions, at least one competitor must be 21 years of age or older.

Music: Cassette tapes or CDs must be clearly marked with the skater's name, club name, and event. Tapes must have the side that is to be played clearly marked and rewind. CDs must have only 1 (one) track per CD in a format that is widely readable by most CD players. **All tapes or CDs must be turned in to the registration desk at least two (2) hours prior to the event.** We recommend that all skaters bring a **backup tape** for each event entered. All competitors' music may be picked up at the registration desk after each event.

<u>Masters</u>	Intermediate Free Skating Test or the 3 rd Figure Test prior to October 1, 1977 or the Adult Gold Free Skating Test.	4:10
<u>Gold</u>	Adult Silver or Adult Gold Free Skating Test and no higher than the Juvenile Free Skating Test or ISI Freestyle 6, or the 2 nd Figure Test prior to October 1, 1977	2:40
<u>Silver</u>	Adult Bronze or Adult Silver Free Skating Test and no higher than the Juvenile Free Skating Test or the ISI Freestyle 5, or the 2 nd Figure Test prior to October 1, 1977.	2:10
	Axels are permitted, however no double jumps are allowed.	
<u>Bronze</u>	Pre-Bronze or Adult Bronze Free Skating Test and no higher than the Preliminary Free Skating Test. and/or ISI Freestyle 4 Test, or the Preliminary Figure Test prior to October 1, 1977	1:40
	No Axels or double jumps are allowed.	
<u>Pre-Bronze</u>	Adult Pre-Bronze Free Skating Test and no higher than Pre-Preliminary Free Skating Test or ISI Freestyle 3.	1:40
	No Lutz, Axel or double jumps are allowed. No flying spins.	
<u>No-Test *</u>	Not have passed any U.S. Figure Skating tests, and no higher than the ISI Freestyle 2.	1:40

Notes:

All times for Adult events are maximum times. No deductions for programs that are shorter in length.

See US Figure Skating rules 3730-3803 for descriptions of Adult Free Skating Well Balanced Programs.

PAIRS FREESKATING EVENTS:

The events may be combined depending on the number of competitors.

Event	Requirements	Max Time
<u>Masters</u>	One skater must have passed at least Intermediate Pairs or FS test. The other skater must have passed Adult Gold pair or Adult Gold FS test.	3:40
<u>Gold</u>	One skater must have passed (but not higher than) Adult Gold Pair or FS, Juv. Pair or FS. Other skater must be at least Adult Silver.	3:10
<u>Silver</u>	One skater must have passed (but not higher than) Adult Silver Pair or FS, Pre-Juv. Pair or FS. Other skater must be at least Adult Bronze.	2:40
<u>Bronze</u>	Both skaters must have passed (but not higher than) Adult Bronze Pair or FS, Preliminary Pair or FS.	2:10

See US Figure Skating rules 4110-4125 for more detail.

COUPLES DANCE EVENTS:

At least one partner must be 21 years old.

Championship/Gold Dance — One partner in the Adult Gold Dance event must have passed at least one Gold/Adult Gold dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Pre-Gold/Adult Pre-Gold dance.
Dances: Paso Doble, Westminster Waltz. Vocal music is allowed.

Pre-Gold Dance — One partner in the Pre-Gold Dance event must have passed at least one Pre-Gold/Adult Pre-Gold dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Silver/Adult Silver dance. Neither partner may have completed the Gold/Adult Gold Dance Test.
Dances: Rocker Foxtrot, Kilian. Vocal music is allowed.

Silver Dance — One partner in the Silver Dance event must have passed at least one Silver/Adult Silver dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Pre-Silver/Adult Pre-Silver dance. Neither partner may have passed more than one Pre-Gold/Adult Pre-Gold dance.
Dances: Fourteen Step, Blues.

Pre-Silver Dance — One partner in the Pre-Silver Dance event must have passed at least one Pre-Silver/Adult Pre-Silver dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Bronze/Adult Bronze dance. Neither partner may have passed more than one Silver/Adult Silver dance.
Dances: Hickory Hoedown, American Waltz.

Bronze Dance — One partner in the Bronze Dance event must have passed at least one Bronze/Adult Bronze dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Pre-Bronze dance. Neither partner may have passed more than one Pre-Silver/Adult Pre-Silver dance.
Dances: Hickory Hoedown, Fourteen Step.

Pre-Bronze Dance -- One partner in the Pre-Bronze Dance event must have passed at least one Pre-Bronze dance and the other partner must have passed at least the Preliminary Dance Test. Neither partner may have passed more than one Pre-Silver/Adult Pre-Silver dances. Dances: Rhythm Blues, Swing.

ORIGINAL DANCE EVENTS:

The rhythms for the original dance will be the Rhythm Combination, any 2 or 3 of the following: Foxtrot, Quickstep, and Charleston. Vocal music is allowed. Music not to exceed 2:15.

Championship -- One partner in the Championship Original Dance event must have passed at least one Championship/Adult Championship dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Gold/Adult Gold dance.

Gold -- One partner in the Championship Original Dance event must have passed at least one Gold/Adult Gold dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Pre-Gold/Adult Pre-Gold dance.

Pre-Gold -- One partner in the Championship Original Dance event must have passed at least one Pre-Gold/Adult Pre-Gold dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Silver/Adult Silver dance.

SOLO DANCE EVENTS:

Competitors in the Solo Dance events may compete at the test level that he or she has partially tested, completed, or one level higher than he or she has completed.

The number of patterns to be skated is two. The dances shall all be started towards the judges.

Event Dances

Gold Open Solo Westminster Waltz and Quickstep.
(May have passed International dances.)

Pre-Gold Solo Blues and Kilian.

Silver Solo Rocker Foxtrot and Tango .

Pre-Silver Solo Fourteen Step and European Waltz.

Bronze Solo Hickory Hoedown and Willow Waltz

Pre-Bronze Solo Cha-Cha and Fiesta Tango.

Preliminary Solo Dutch Waltz and Rhythm Blues.

INTERPRETIVE EVENTS:

Scoring: Young Adult, Adult, and Masters Interpretive Free Skating shall consist of a variety of skating moves and elements selected for their value in enhancing the skater's interpretation of the music he or she has chosen. Axels and double jumps will not be permitted. Costumes that enhance the performance by appropriately reflecting the character of the music, thereby enhancing the theme, will be considered in the judging. Props on the ice will not be permitted.

Two marks will be given by the judges, the first for **Skating Technique** and the second for **Presentation**.

In marking **Skating Technique**, these aspects will be considered: the ease, flow, glide, sureness, power, and depth of edges; the ability to vary the speed and direction of the skating; the variety of expressive and innovative moves; the succession of movement within the program; the utilization of space and ice coverage; and style.

In marking **Presentation**, these aspects will be considered: the interpretation of the music and rhythm; the skater's musical timing and understanding of the phrasing of music; the use of the entire body to develop artistic and music expression; creativity; choreography and the art of arranging movements; variations in tempo, tension, emotion, and movements; the suitability of the music to the skater; and the internal motivation of movements and expression projected to the audience.

Music -- Vocal music is permitted. Check each level for maximum times. Notice that the maximum time for the Masters events is longer than specified in rule 3810.

Age Categories -- Age categories will be the same as for Free Skating events as presented in Section 1, but may be combined at the discretion of the Competition Committee, with the exception of Young Adult. Young Adult entrants will enter either **Young Adult Masters Interpretive** or **Young Adult Interpretive**, depending upon their test qualifications.

Event	Requirements	Max Time
Masters	Meets the requirements for Adult Gold Free Skating event or Masters Free Skating or Pair events, or passed at least one of the Silver/Adult Silver dances	2:10
Adult	Meets the requirements of the Adult Bronze Free Skating event and not exceed the requirements of the Adult Silver Free Skating event and no higher than the completed Pre-Silver/ Adult Pre-Silver Dance test.	1:40
Pairs	Either mixed or similar sex. Both must meet the requirements of Adult Pre-Bronze Free Skating event. No lifts, Axels, nor double jumps permitted.	1:40

* A competitor can enter the pairs event as well as an individual interpretive event.

TIES:

Ties will be broken by Total Ordinals, if still tied the second Move (or final Dance) will break the tie.

MOVES IN THE FIELD EVENTS:

Junior/Senior - No test restrictions are placed on this level. Moves to be skated:

Extension Spiral Step; Forward and Backward Inside Rockers.

Novice - A competitor in the Novice Moves event must not have passed any higher than the Novice Moves or Novice Free Skating Tests, the Adult or Standard Silver Dance Test, or the Adult Gold Free Skating Test. Moves to be skated:
Outside Counters; Backward Rocker Choctaw Sequence.

Adult Gold - A competitor in the Gold Moves event must not have passed any test higher than the Juvenile Moves or Juvenile Free Skating tests, the Adult or Standard Silver Dance Test, or the Adult Gold Free Skating Test. Moves to be skated:
Forward double 3-turns; Brackets in the Field.

Adult Silver - A competitor in the Silver Moves event must not have passed any test higher than the Pre-Juvenile Moves or Pre-Juvenile Free Skating Tests, the Adult or Standard Pre-Silver Dance Test, or the Adult Silver Free Skating Test. Moves to be skated:
Forward Cross Strokes; FO-BI 3-turns in the Field.

Adult Bronze - A competitor in the Bronze Moves event must not have passed any test higher than the Preliminary Moves or Preliminary Free Skating Tests, the Bronze Dance Test, or the Adult Bronze Free Skating Test. Moves to be skated:
Backward Power Perimeter Stroking; Five Step Mohawk Sequence.

Adult Pre-Bronze - A competitor in the Pre-Bronze Moves event must not have passed any test higher than the Pre-Preliminary Moves or Pre-Preliminary Free Skating Tests, the Pre-Bronze Dance Test, or the Adult Pre-Bronze Free Skating Test. Moves to be skated:
Backward Crossovers Both Directions, Forward Perimeter Stroking.

SPIN EVENTS:

Spins must be skated exactly as stated but may be skated in any order. Connecting steps may be used but will not affect scoring. All Spin events are skated without music on 1/2 ice surface.

Event	Required Elements	Max Time
Gold/Masters	Solo spin (min. 5 revs); Jump spin (min. 4 revs); Combination Spin with only one change of foot and at least two changes of position (min 4 revs each foot).	1:30
Silver	Forward Camel Spin (min 3 revs); Layback, Attitude or Sit Spin (min 4 revs); Combination Spin with only one change of position – change of foot optional (min 3 revs each position)	1:30
Bronze	One Foot Upright Spin (min 4 revs); One Foot Back Spin (entry optional, min 3 revs); Sit Spin, broken leg or attitude (min 3 revs).	1:30
Pre-Bronze	One Foot Upright Spin (min 3 revs, optional leg position); Two Foot Spin (entry optional, min 3 revs); Pivot.	1:15

NOTE: Only one attempt per element is permitted for Spins, Jumps and Compulsory Moves events.

COMPULSORY MOVES EVENTS:

Moves must be performed without music and in any order with connecting steps necessary to link the various moves together. Except for Gold/Masters, limited to 1/2 ice surface. Mandatory deductions will be taken for unlisted or additional elements such as jumps, spins, repetitions or unsuccessfully executed moves.

Gold/Masters	Axel; Lutz-Loop combination; Waltz - half-Loop - Flip combination; Camel-sit spin (min 4 revs each); straight-line footwork sequence; layback or attitude (ladies) or cross-foot (men) spin. Full ice surface is to be used.	2:00
Silver	Flip; Loop; Single-single combination jump; Camel spin (min 3 revs); back spin; straight-line footwork sequence.	1:30
Bronze	Salchow; Toe-Loop; Waltz-Toe-Loop combination; sit spin (min 3 revs); straight-line footwork sequence.	1:00
Pre-Bronze	Waltz jump; Toe-Loop; half-Flip - half-Flip combination; one foot spin (min 3 revs)	1:00
No-Test *	Two-foot spin (min. 3 revs); Forward Edges (minimum 2 outside and 2 inside, skated consecutively); Bunny Hop; Lunge; forward inside pivot.	1:00

JUMPS ONLY EVENTS:

Jumps must be skated exactly as stated and in the order stated. Connecting steps may be used but will not affect scoring. All Jump events are skated without music on 1/2 ice surface, except for Gold/Masters which is skated on full ice.

Gold/Masters	Lutz; Axel; Two jump combinations (may include doubles).	1:30
Silver	Flip; Loop; Single/single combination.	1:15
Bronze	Salchow; Loop; Single/Single combination.	1:00
Pre-Bronze	Waltz; Waltz/Toe-Loop combination; Half Flip.	1:00

TEAM MANEUVERS:

Each team will consist of three to five members with one maneuver performed by each member. Both men and ladies may compete on the same team. If a team member is unable to compete due to illness or injury, a teammate may perform his/her maneuver with proper notice to the event referee. Each skater may perform no more than two elements. Skaters do not have to represent the same club. A skater may compete on one team only. Each team must construct a sign or poster with the team name prominently displayed. Skaters may skate up one level from their Free Skate test level

Bronze — Passed no higher than Preliminary or Bronze FS Test

1. Waltz/toe loop jump
2. Any single/single combination jump
3. Spiral (forward and backward)
4. One-foot spin (any position or direction)
5. Sit-spin (min 3 revs)

Gold — Passed no higher than Juvenile or Gold FS Test

1. Axel jump
2. Any single/single combination jump
3. Layback or crossfoot spin
4. Camel/sit spin combination
5. Spiral step sequence.

III. Entries and Registration

Entries must be postmarked no later than July 21st, 2005. Blank entry forms may be copied. Partner entries for pairs and team dance should be mailed together in the same envelope. Entry fees are as follows:

- \$75.00** for first singles, interpretive, or solo event except solo dance;
- 35.00** for second such event;
- 35.00** for each partner of mixed pair, similar pair interpretive or dance team
- 45.00** for solo dance
- 15.00** for each member of a team maneuvers team

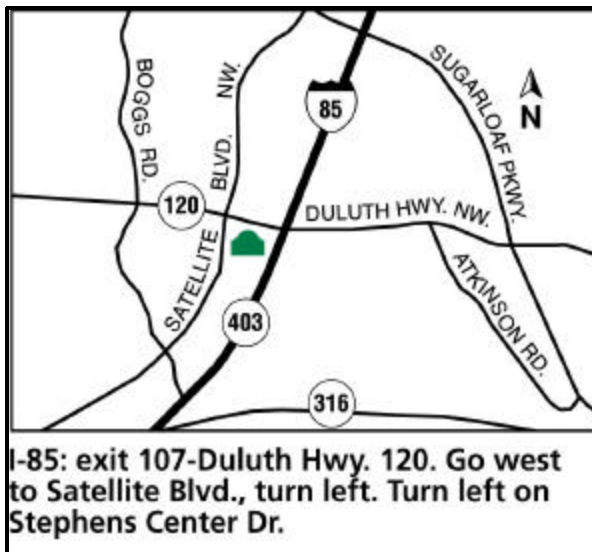
