# The 2010 Peach Classic

## I. General Information

**Eligibility:** All competitors must be either: 1) a member in good standing of a club having membership in U.S. Figure Skating; 2) an individual member of U.S. Figure Skating; 3) a member of a national figure skating association that is a member of the ISU. Entries from members of clubs with a probationary status will be accepted provided the entry is accompanied by a signed certification by the skater that he or she is properly qualified to participate in the event(s) entered. Skaters may compete in as many disciplines as qualified by test level and age, but may compete in only one event per discipline; competitors may enter both team and solo dance events. Age and test qualifications as of July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2010 (close of entries), will determine classification.

**All skaters must compete at the level of their highest passed freestyle test, or one level higher. Pairs and Dance competitors must meet the requirements listed in that section of this announcement.**

**Entries:** Entries must be postmarked no later than July 17, 2010. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Committee and will require a late fee of \$30.00.

No refunds will be granted under any circumstances. The Georgia Figure Skating Club reserves the right to divide or combine any event if necessary and to cancel any events (with full refund of entry fee) if fewer than two entries are received.

**Music:** CDs are the only acceptable forms of media. Cassettes will NOT be accepted. CDs must be clearly marked with name, event entered and the music length. Each CD must have only ONE (1) track on it. Any disc with more than one (1) track will NOT be accepted! Each CD must be in a standard hard sided "jewel case" or CD sleeve. **Due to compatibility and reliability reasons music MAY NOT be submitted on re-recordable "CD-RW" discs.**

**Age Categories:** The following age categories apply to all events:

Young Adult*	18 to 20 years old
Class I	21 to 30 years old
Class II	31 to 40 years old
Class III	41 to 50 years old
Class IV	51 to 60 years old
Class V	61 years old & over

All age categories may be divided or combined depending on the number of registrations; there must be two (2) or more entries to hold an event. **Proof of age is required for all events.** Copy of birth certificate, passport, driver's license or similar proof of age is considered acceptable, but the Competition Committee reserves the right to require additional documentation.

\*Note: The Young Adult age category applies to most events. However, in Couples Dance events, at least one competitor must be 21 years of age or older.

**Registration Desk:** Will be open at the rink during the scheduled events. Skaters are required to check the official bulletin board at the rink for the scheduled events. The posting of such notices, changes or announcements shall be considered sufficient notice to competitors.

**Schedule:** A final schedule will be available at the registration desk, which will be open throughout the competition. **A schedule will be posted on the GaFSC web site at [www.gafsc.org/peachclassic/](http://www.gafsc.org/peachclassic/) no later than two weeks before the event.**

**Judging System:** The ISU judging system (IJS) will be used for Gold through Masters Freeskate and Pairs. A Planned Program Content form must be submitted for all events being judged under the ISU system.

**The 6.0 judging system will be used for all other events.**

The well balanced program requirements within each category of Singles, Pairs and Dance for the 2010-2011 season will be observed

### **SINGLES FREESKATING EVENTS:**

<b><u>Masters Junior/Senior</u></b>	See rules 3740, 3741	<b>3:40</b>
<b><u>Masters Intermediate/Novice</u></b>	See rules 3745, 3746.	<b>3:10</b>
<b><u>Gold</u></b>	See rules 3780 & 3781.	<b>2:40</b>
<b><u>Silver</u></b>	See rules 3790 & 3791.	<b>2:10</b>
<b><u>Bronze</u></b>	See rules 3800, 3801.	<b>1:50</b>
<b><u>Pre-Bronze</u></b>	See rules 3805 & 3806.	<b>1:40</b>
<b><u>No-Test</u> *</b>	May not have passed any official U.S. Figure Skating free skating tests (Pre-Bronze MIF and Pre-Pre MIF allowed), and no higher than the ISI Freestyle 2. Only half jumps, Salchow, and Toe Loop jumps are allowed. Max 3 jump elements, 2 spins, 1 step sequence (1/2 sheet).	<b>1:40</b>

\* U.S. Figure Skating Basic Skills Membership can be used for events marked with an asterisk. Skater must provide a copy of their card, or be a full member of a U.S. Figure Skating club.

#### **Notes:**

All times for Adult events are maximum times. No deductions for programs that are shorter in length.

### **PAIRS FREESKATING EVENTS:**

(The events may be combined depending on the number of competitors.)

<b>Event</b>	<b>Requirements</b>	<b>Max Time</b>
<b><u>Masters</u></b>	One skater must have passed at least Intermediate Pairs or FS test. The other skater must have passed Adult Gold Pair or Adult Gold FS test. See rules 4115 & 4116 .	<b>3:40</b>
<b><u>Gold</u></b>	One skater must have passed (but not higher than) Adult Gold Pair or FS, Juv. Pair or FS. Other skater must be at least Adult Silver. See rules 4120 & 4121.	<b>3:40</b>
<b><u>Silver</u></b>	One skater must have passed at least Adult Silver Pair or FS, Pre-Juv. FS. But no higher than Adult Gold or Juv. FS. Other skater must be at least Adult Bronze. See rules 4122 & 4123.	<b>2:40</b>
<b><u>Bronze</u></b>	Both skaters must have passed Adult Bronze Pair or FS, Prelim. Pair or FS. But no higher than Adult Silver or Pre-Juv FS. See rules 4124 & 4125.	<b>2:10</b>

### **INTERPRETIVE EVENTS:**

**Scoring:** Young Adult, Adult, and Masters Interpretive Free Skating shall consist of a variety of skating moves and elements selected for their value in enhancing the skater's interpretation of the music he or she has chosen. Axels and double jumps will not be permitted. Costumes that enhance the performance by appropriately reflecting the character of the music, thereby enhancing the theme, will be considered in the judging. Props on the ice will not be permitted.

Two marks will be given by the judges, the first for **Skating Technique** and the second for **Presentation**.

In marking **Skating Technique**, these aspects will be considered: the ease, flow, glide, sureness, power, and depth of edges; the ability to vary the speed and direction of the skating; the variety of expressive and innovative moves; the succession of movement within the program; the utilization of space and ice coverage; and style.

In marking **Presentation**, these aspects will be considered: the interpretation of the music and rhythm; the skater's musical timing and understanding of the phrasing of music; the use of the entire body to develop artistic and music expression; creativity; choreography and the art of arranging movements; variations in tempo, tension, emotion, and movements; the suitability of the music to the skater; and the internal motivation of movements and expression projected to the audience.

**Music** -- Vocal music is permitted. Check each level for maximum times.

**Age Categories** -- Age categories will be the same as for Free Skating events as presented in Section 1, but may be combined at the discretion of the Competition Committee, with the exception of

Young Adult. Young Adult entrants will enter either **Young Adult Masters Interpretive** or **Young Adult Interpretive**, depending upon their test qualifications.

<b><u>Masters</u></b>	Meets the requirements for Adult Gold Free Skating event or Masters Free Skating or Pair events, or passed at least one of the Silver/Adult Silver dances	<b>1:40</b>
<b><u>Adult</u></b>	Meets the requirements of the Adult Bronze Free Skating event and not exceed the requirements of the Adult Silver Free Skating event and no higher than the completed Pre-Silver/Adult Pre-Silver Dance test.	<b>1:40</b>
<b><u>Pairs</u></b>	Either mixed or similar sex. Both must meet the requirements of Adult Pre-Bronze Free Skating event. No lifts, Axels, nor double jumps permitted.	<b>1:40</b>

\* A competitor can enter the Interpretive Pairs event as well as an individual interpretive event.

### **COUPLES DANCE EVENTS:**

At least one partner must be at least 21 years old.

**Championship/Gold Dance** — One partner in the Adult Gold Dance event must have passed at least one Gold/Adult Gold dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Pre-Gold/Adult Pre-Gold dance. Dances: Quick Step and Argentine Tango. Vocal music is allowed.

**Pre-Gold Dance** — One partner in the Pre-Gold Dance event must have passed at least one Pre-Gold/Adult Pre-Gold dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Silver/Adult Silver dance. Neither partner may have completed the Gold/Adult Gold Dance Test. Dances: Blues and Starlight Waltz. Vocal music is allowed.

**Silver Dance** — One partner in the Silver Dance event must have passed at least one Silver/Adult Silver dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Pre-Silver/Adult Pre-Silver dance. Neither partner may have passed more than one Pre-Gold/Adult Pre-Gold dance. Dances: European Waltz and Rocker Foxtrot.

**Pre-Silver Dance** — One partner in the Pre-Silver Dance event must have passed at least one Pre-Silver/Adult Pre-Silver dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Bronze/Adult Bronze dance. Neither partner may have passed more than one Silver/Adult Silver dance. Dances: Ten-Fox and European Waltz.

**Bronze Dance** — One partner in the Bronze Dance event must have passed at least one Bronze/Adult Bronze dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Pre-Bronze dance. Neither partner may have passed more than one Pre-Silver/Adult Pre-Silver dance. Dances: Swing Dance and Fiesta Tango.

**Pre-Bronze Dance** -- One partner in the Pre-Bronze Dance event must have passed at least one Pre-Bronze dance and the other partner must have passed at least the Preliminary Dance Test. Neither partner may have passed more than one Pre-Silver/Adult Pre-Silver dances. Dances: Canasta Tango and Swing Dance.

### **FREE DANCE EVENTS:**

The rhythms are to be same as the annual selection by the ISU. Vocal music is allowed. Music not to exceed 3:10.

See rule 4462 for well balanced program elements.

**Championship** -- One partner in the Championship Free Dance event must have passed at least one Pre-Gold dance; the other partner must have passed at least one Silver/Adult Silver dance.

**Gold** -- One partner in the Gold Free Dance event must have passed at least one Gold/Adult Gold dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Pre-Gold/Adult Pre-Gold dance. Any skater who has passed one or more pre-gold dance(s) prior to age 21 or has competed in any standard track qualifying dance event at sectionals or higher before or after the age of 21 will be ineligible to compete in this event.

**Pre-Gold** -- One partner in the Championship Free Dance event must have passed at least one Pre-Gold/Adult Pre-Gold dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Silver/Adult Silver dance. Neither partner may have completed the Gold/Adult Gold dance test.

### **SOLO DANCE EVENTS:**

Competitors in the Solo Dance events may compete at the test level that he or she has partially tested, completed, or one level higher than he or she has completed.

The number of patterns to be skated is two. The dances shall all be started towards the judges.

<b>Event</b>	<b>Dances</b>
<b><u>Gold/Open Solo</u></b>	Blues and Quickstep. (May have passed International dances.)
<b><u>Silver Solo</u></b>	European Waltz and Rocker Foxtrot
<b><u>Bronze Solo</u></b>	Fiesta Tango and Willow Waltz
<b><u>Preliminary Solo</u></b>	Canasta Tango and Rhythm Blues.

### **TIES:**

**Ties will be broken by Total Ordinals, if still tied the second mark (or final Dance) will break the tie.**

**MOVES IN THE FIELD EVENTS:**

**Junior/Senior** - No test restrictions are placed on this level. Moves to be skated:

Extension Spiral Step; Forward and Backward Inside Rockers.

**Novice** - A competitor in the Novice Moves event must not have passed any higher than the Novice Moves or Novice Free Skating Tests, the Adult or Standard Silver Dance Test, or the Adult Gold Free Skating Test. Moves to be skated:  
Outside Counters; Backward Rocker Choctaw Sequence.

**Adult Gold** - A competitor in the Gold Moves event must not have passed any test higher than the Juvenile Moves or Juvenile Free Skating tests, the Adult or Standard Silver Dance Test, or the Adult Gold Free Skating Test. Moves to be skated:  
Forward Double 3-Turns; Inside Slide Chasse pattern

**Adult Silver** - A competitor in the Silver Moves event must not have passed any test higher than the Pre-Juvenile Moves or Pre-Juvenile Free Skating Tests, the Adult or Standard Pre-Silver Dance Test, or the Adult Silver Free Skating Test. Moves to be skated:  
Forward and Backward Power Change of Edge pulls; Eight Step Mohawk sequence.

**Adult Bronze** - A competitor in the Bronze Moves event must not have passed any test higher than the Preliminary Moves or Preliminary Free Skating Tests, the Bronze Dance Test, or the Adult Bronze Free Skating Test. Moves to be skated:  
Backward Power Perimeter Stroking; Five Step Mohawk Sequence.

**Adult Pre-Bronze** - A competitor in the Pre-Bronze Moves event must not have passed any test higher than the Pre-Preliminary Moves or Pre-Preliminary Free Skating Tests, the Pre-Bronze Dance Test, or the Adult Pre-Bronze Free Skating Test. Moves to be skated:  
Backward Crossovers; Waltz Eight.

**SPIN EVENTS:**

Spins must be skated exactly as stated but may be skated in any order. Connecting steps may be used but will not affect scoring. All Spin events are skated without music on ½ ice surface.

<b>Gold/Masters</b>	Solo spin (min. 5 revs); Jump spin (min. 4 revs); Combination Spin with only one change of foot and at least two changes of position (min 4 revs each foot).	<b>1:30</b>
<b>Silver</b>	Forward Camel Spin (min 3 revs); Layback, Attitude or Sit Spin (min 4 revs); Combination Spin with only one change of position – change of foot optional (min 3 revs each position)	<b>1:30</b>
<b>Bronze</b>	One Foot Upright Spin (min 4 revs); One Foot Back Spin (entry optional, min 3 revs); Sit Spin, broken leg or attitude (min 3 revs).	<b>1:30</b>
<b>Pre-Bronze</b>	One Foot Upright Spin (min 3 revs, optional leg position); Two Foot Spin (entry optional, min 3 revs); Pivot.	<b>1:15</b>

**COMPULSORY MOVES EVENTS:**

Moves must be performed without music and in any order with connecting steps necessary to link the various moves together. Except for Gold/Masters, limited to 1/2 ice surface. Mandatory deductions will be taken for unlisted or additional elements such as jumps, spins, repetitions or unsuccessfully executed moves.

<b>Gold/Masters</b>	Axel; Lutz-Loop combination; Waltz - half Loop - Flip combination; Camel-sit spin (min 4 revs each); straight-line footwork sequence; layback or attitude (ladies) or cross-foot (men) spin. Full ice surface is to be used.	<b>2:00</b>
<b>Silver</b>	Flip; Loop; Single-single combination jump; Camel spin (min 3 revs); back spin; straight-line footwork sequence.	<b>1:30</b>
<b>Bronze</b>	Salchow; Toe Loop; Waltz-Toe Loop combination; sit spin (min 3 revs); straight-line footwork sequence.	<b>1:00</b>
<b>Pre-Bronze</b>	Waltz jump; Toe Loop; half Flip - half Flip combination; one foot spin (min 3 revs)	<b>1:00</b>
<b>No-Test *</b>	Two-foot spin (min. 3 revs); Forward Edges (minimum 2 outside and 2 inside, skated consecutively); Bunny Hop; Lunge; forward inside pivot.	<b>1:00</b>

**JUMPS ONLY EVENTS:**

Jumps must be skated exactly as stated and in the order stated. Connecting steps may be used but will not affect scoring. All Jump events are skated without music on ½ ice surface, except for Gold/Masters which is skated on full ice.

<b>Gold/Masters</b>	Lutz; Axel; Two jump combinations (may include doubles).	<b>1:30</b>
<b>Silver</b>	Flip; Loop; Single/single combination.	<b>1:15</b>
<b>Bronze</b>	Salchow; Loop; Single/Single combination.	<b>1:00</b>
<b>Pre-Bronze</b>	Waltz; Waltz/Toe Loop combination; Half Flip.	<b>1:00</b>

**NOTE: Only one attempt per element is permitted for Spin, Jump and Compulsory Moves events.**

**TEAM MANEUVERS:**

Each team will consist of three to five members with one maneuver performed by each member. Both men and ladies may compete on the same team. If a team member is unable to compete due to illness or injury, a teammate may perform his/her maneuver with proper notice to the event referee. Each skater may perform no more than two elements. Skaters do not have to represent the same club. A skater may compete on one team only. Each team must construct a sign or poster with the team name prominently displayed. Skaters may skate up one level from their Free Skate test level

**Bronze** — Passed no higher than Preliminary or Bronze FS Test

1. Waltz/toe loop jump
2. Any single/single combination jump
3. Spiral (forward and backward)
4. One-foot spin (any position or direction)
5. Sit-spin (min 3 revs)

**Gold** — Passed no higher than Juvenile or Gold FS Test

1. Axel jump
2. Any single/single combination jump
3. Layback or cross foot spin
4. Camel/sit spin combination
5. Spiral step sequence.

**III. Entries and Registration**

Entries must be postmarked no later than July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2010. Blank entry forms may be copied. Partner entries for pairs and team dance should be mailed together in the same envelope. Entry fees are as follows:

First Event:

- \$90.00** for first singles event that uses the ISU judging system (IJS)
- \$80.00** for first singles, interpretive, or other event that uses the 6.0 judging system
- \$45.00** for each partner of pair, pair interpretive or dance team;
- \$40.00** for each additional solo/singles event
- \$20.00** for each member of a team maneuvers team;
