I. General Information

Eligibility: This Competition is open to all qualified eligible skaters who are members in good standing of U.S. Figure Skating or the ISU, and will be governed by the rules of U.S. Figure Skating as specified in the 2006-2007 Rule Book. Also, the No Test events may be entered by skaters in the Basic Skills program of U.S. Figure Skating.

The purpose of this non-qualifying competition is to provide a practical competitive experience in freestyle, pairs and dance. With this object in mind, Junior and Senior events will **NOT** be subdivided.

Age and test qualifications as of July 15, 2006 (close of entries) will determine classification.

Entries: Entries must be postmarked no later than July 15, 2006. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Committee and will require a late fee of \$25.00.

The Georgia Figure Skating Club reserves the right to divide or combine any event if necessary and to cancel any events (with full refund of entry fee). Any other refunds will be made **only** with a physician's note and at the discretion of the Georgia Figure Skating Club. Competition cancellations due to acts of God will not be refunded.

Registration Desk: Will be open at the rink during the scheduled events. A tentative schedule will be posted at the rink. Skaters are required to check the official bulletin board at the rink for the scheduled events. The posting of such notices, changes or announcements shall be considered sufficient notice to competitors.

Critiques: Critiques will be offered for Intermediate and above for the short programs only.

Judging System: The 6.0 judging system will be used for all events.

Schedule: A final schedule will be available at the registration desk. **A schedule will be posted on the GaFSC web site at: www.gafsc.org/peachopen/ when available.**

Final Rounds: Final rounds will be held in Novice, Intermediate and Juvenile Free Skating singles, providing there are enough entries to subdivide the class in accordance with Rule 3276. In Novice and Intermediate, the initial round will consist of both short and long programs. The final rounds will be in accordance with Rule 3276.

Music: Cassette tapes or CDs must be clearly marked with the skater's name, club name, and event. Tapes must have the side that is to be played clearly marked and rewind. CDs must have only 1 (one) track per CD in a format that is widely readable by most CD players. **All tapes or CDs must be turned in to the registration desk at least two (2) hours prior to the event.** We recommend that all skaters bring a **backup tape** for each event entered. All competitors' music may be picked up at the registration desk after each event.

Rink: All events will be held at the **Atlanta IceForum**, 2300 Satellite Boulevard, Duluth, GA, 30097

The rink is a climate-controlled facility with a double ice surface, each measuring 200' by 85' with rounded corners and a hockey barrier.

SHOWCASE EVENTS:

Scoring: Showcase shall consist of a variety of skating moves and elements selected for their value in enhancing the skater's interpretation of the music he or she has chosen. Axels and double jumps will not be permitted. Costumes that enhance the performance by appropriately reflecting the character of the music, thereby enhancing the theme, will be considered in the judging. Props on the ice will not be permitted.

Two marks will be given by the judges, the first for **Skating Technique** and the second for **Presentation**.

In marking **Skating Technique**, these aspects will be considered: the

ease, flow, glide, sureness, power, and depth of edges; the ability to vary the speed and direction of the skating; the variety of expressive and innovative moves; the succession of movement within the program; the utilization of space and ice coverage; and style.

In marking **Presentation**, these aspects will be considered: the interpretation of the music and rhythm; the skater's musical timing and understanding of the phrasing of music; the use of the entire body to develop artistic and music expression; creativity; choreography and the art of arranging movements; variations in tempo, tension, emotion, and movements; the suitability of the music to the skater; and the internal motivation of movements and expression projected to the audience.

Music -- Vocal music is permitted. Check each level for maximum times.

COMPULSORY MOVES EVENTS:

Skating is done on half the ice surface for No Test through Pre-Juvenile, and the full ice for Juvenile. Programs are skated without music. Skaters must compete at the level of their highest passed freestyle test, or one level higher. Elements are to be skated in any order with connecting steps, as necessary. Deductions will be taken for additional elements such as jumps, spins, repetitions or unsuccessfully executed moves. **Only one attempt is permitted for each element.**

All dances and age requirements will be as listed in the rulebook for the 2006-2007 season. Each event listed is a separate event and will not be combined.

SPIN EVENTS:

Skaters must compete at the level of their highest passed freestyle test, or one level higher. All events are on half the rink. Connecting steps may be used, but will not affect scoring. Spins must be skated exactly as stated, but may be skated in any order.
