I. General Information

Eligibility: This Competition is open to all qualified eligible skaters who are members in good standing of U.S. Figure Skating or the ISU, and will be governed by the rules of U.S. Figure Skating as specified in the 2009-2010 Rule Book. Also, the No Test events may be entered by skaters in the Basic Skills program of U.S. Figure Skating.

The purpose of this non-qualifying competition is to provide a practical competitive experience in freestyle skating. With this object in mind, Junior and Senior events will **NOT** be subdivided.

Age and test qualifications as of July 6, 2009 (close of entries) will determine classification.

Entries: Entries must be postmarked no later than July 6, 2009. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Committee and will require a late fee of \$30.00.

The Georgia Figure Skating Club reserves the right to divide or combine any event if necessary and to cancel any events (with full refund of entry fee). Any other refunds will be made **only** with a physician's note and at the discretion of the Georgia Figure Skating Club. Competition cancellations due to acts of God will not be refunded.

Registration Desk: Will be open at the rink during the scheduled events. Skaters are required to check the official bulletin board at the rink for the scheduled events. The posting of such notices, changes or announcements shall be considered sufficient notice to competitors.

Schedule: A final schedule will be available at the registration desk. **A schedule will be posted on the GaFSC web site at: www.gafsc.org/peachopen/ no later than two weeks before the event.**

Final Rounds: Final rounds will be held in Novice, Intermediate and Juvenile Free Skating singles, providing there are enough entries to subdivide the class in accordance with Rule 3276. In Novice and Intermediate, the initial round will consist of both short and long programs. The final rounds will be in accordance with Rule 3276.

Judging System: The ISU judging system (IJS) will be used for Juvenile through Senior Freeskate and Short Program events. A Planned Program Content form must be submitted for all events being judged under the ISU system.

The 6.0 judging system will be used for all other events.

The rink is a climate-controlled facility with a double ice surface, each measuring 200' by 85' with rounded corners and a hockey barrier.

Music: **CDs are the only acceptable forms of media.** Cassettes will NOT be accepted. CDs must be clearly marked with name, event entered and the music length. Each CD must have only ONE (1) track on it. Any disc with more than one (1) track will NOT be accepted! Each CD must be in a standard hard sided "jewel case" or CD sleeve. **Due to compatibility and reliability reasons, music MAY NOT be submitted on re-recordable "CD-RW" discs.**

All CDs must be turned in to the registration desk at least two (2) hours prior to the event. We recommend that all skaters bring a **backup CD** for each event entered. All competitors' music may be picked up at the registration desk after each event.

II. Composition of Events

Pre-Preliminary-A	Passed no Freestyle test higher than Pre-Preliminary. Maximum 5 jump elements. No Axel nor double jumps. Up to 3 of the jump elements may be combinations or sequences. One jump combo can contain 3 jumps, the remaining combinations are limited to 2 jumps. Sequences are not limited to the number of jumps. See rules 3630, 3711	1:30 (+/- :10)
Pre-Preliminary-B	Passed no Freestyle test higher than Pre-Preliminary. Maximum 5 jump elements. Axel is permitted, however no double or triple jumps. Axel may be repeated but must be in combination. COMPULSORY MOVES EVENTS:

Skating is done on half the ice surface for No Test through Pre-Juvenile, and the full ice for Juvenile. Programs are skated without music. Skaters must compete at the level of their highest passed freestyle test, or one level higher. Elements are to be skated in any order with connecting steps, as necessary. Deductions will be taken for additional elements such as jumps, spins, repetitions or unsuccessfully executed moves. **Only one attempt is permitted for each element.**

SPIN EVENTS:

Skaters must compete at the level of their highest passed freestyle test, or one level higher. Connecting steps may be used, but will not affect scoring. Spins must be skated exactly as stated, but may be skated in any order. **All events are limited to 1/2 ice surface.**

Skaters must compete at the level of their highest passed freestyle test, or one level higher. Jumps must be skated exactly as stated, in the exact order stated, with minimal connecting steps, except as noted below.

Notes:

Jumps followed by a “*”, must be immediately preceded by connecting steps.

Only one attempt is permitted for each element of Jumps, Spins and Compulsory Moves events.

SHOWCASE EVENTS:

Scoring: Showcase shall consist of a variety of skating moves and elements selected for their value in enhancing the skater's interpretation of the music he or she has chosen.

Costumes that enhance the performance by appropriately reflecting the character of the music, thereby enhancing the theme, will be considered in the judging. Two marks will be given by the judges, the first for **Skating Technique** and the second for **Presentation**.

In marking **Skating Technique**, these aspects will be considered: the ease, flow, glide, sureness, power, and depth of edges; the ability to vary the speed and direction of the skating; the variety of expressive and innovative moves; the succession of movement within the program; the utilization of space and ice coverage; and style.

In marking **Presentation**, these aspects will be considered: the interpretation of the music and rhythm; the skater's musical timing and understanding of the phrasing of music; the use of the entire body to develop artistic and music expression; creativity; choreography and the art of arranging movements; variations in tempo, tension, emotion, and movements; the suitability of the music to the skater; and the internal motivation of movements and expression projected to the audience.

Props — Props are limited to those that the skater can carry or push onto the ice unassisted. Set-up time is limited to 30 seconds. Flames, smoke, wet mops, whipped or shaving cream, cap guns, loud noises, and any substance that may alter the ice in any way are prohibited.

Music — Vocal music is permitted. Check each level for maximum times.

Competitive Test Track

Skaters may enter EITHER the test track free skate program or the well-balanced track free skate program but **NOT** both during the same non-qualifying competition. Competitors will skate to music of their choice. 6.0 Judging will be used.

Deductions WILL be made for skaters including technical elements not permitted in the event description.

- 0.1 from EACH mark for each technical element included that is not permitted in the event description.
- 0.2 from the technical mark for each extra or lacking element.
- 0.1 for any spin with less than required revolutions.
