

Alexander Aiken To Compete at North American Challenge Skate Series

Atlanta FSC member **Alexander Aiken**, Intermediate Men's silver medalist at the 2006 U.S. Junior Championships, has been selected to compete at the Pittsburgh North American Challenge Skate series on August 24 - 27. He has also been named to the 2006 - 2007 U.S. Figure Skating Developmental Team and will receive supplemental funding of \$1,500 to enhance his training.

The North American Challenge Skate events began in the summer of 1996 and are jointly sponsored by U.S. Figure Skating and Skate Canada and conducted in accordance with existing U.S. Figure Skating/Skate Canada regulations for novice and junior events in ladies, men, pairs and ice dancing. NACS events are open to eligible skaters from U.S. Figure Skating, Skate Canada and invited guests from the Mexican Federation. All athletes are named to compete by their respective national association. Each association determines specific eligibility criteria for its own skaters through its own selection process.

NACS events give young competitors their first taste of international experience as members of Team USA. Former gold medalists at NACS events include Sasha Cohen, Bebe Liang, Johnny Weir and Evan Lysacek.

An adult skater and U.S. Figure Skating gold test judge, **Sharon Hyre**, SICSC president, served as president of the Atlanta FSC from 1993 - 1996, 1999 - 2002, and 2005 - 2006. She is the founder of the Magnolia Open competition and has chaired the Magnolia Open and volunteered as hospitality chair of several Atlanta Open competitions, the 2006 Eastern Synchronized Team Championships, and the 1992 Skate America competitions. She has also represented the Atlanta FSC for the past several years as a delegate at the annual U.S. Figure Skating Governing Council. Most recently, she was a member of the 2004 State Farm U.S. Championships Local Organizing Committee Board of Directors, managing hospitality, merchandising, and the competitors' party. She has been appointed parliamentarian of the Atlanta FSC for 2006 - 2007 and will chair hospitality for the 2007 Eastern Sectional Championships.

Rob Lichtefeld, SICSC vice president, has been skating since January,1997, when he learned how to go backwards in an adult group class. He joined the Georgia FSC in 2000 when he began testing and competing and was elected to their Board of Directors in 2001, serving as secretary from 2001 - 2004. Since then he has functioned as President and is also the competition chairperson and webmaster. Rob currently competes in adult silver in singles and adult gold or silver in pairs (depending on the partner) at several competitions a year, including international events. He and Phyllis Friello won first place at the 2006 Mountain Cup in Villard-de-Lans, France in Gold Pairs. He also served as venue manager of Philips Arena for the 2004 State Farm U.S. Figure Skating Championships.

Rule 3102: Registration for Qualifying Competitions - Singles, Pairs, and Dance

Effective with the 2006 - 2007 skating season, single skaters not competing in pairs or dance must compete in the region where legal residence is established or where the principle training center is located as listed on the entry form.

Pairs and dance skaters must compete at the regional championships held in the region in which their home club is located.

Rule 3212: Entries - Qualifying Competitions (Effective July 1, 2006)

PAPER qualifying competition entry for singles, pairs, dance must be postmarked on or before <u>August 25</u>. Paper entries submitted after August 25 and up to September 1 must be submitted by overnight service that provides dated evidence of the entry submission. <u>Skaters who test after August 25 must either use the</u> online process, hand deliver or submit their entries by overnight delivery service (USPS, UPS, FedEx). Add Item D: All withdrawals will be considered final and the skater may not re-enter the qualifying competition even if before the entry deadline. <u>This is</u> <u>effective July 1, 2006.</u>

Rule 3661: Novice Men Short Program (Technical Elements)

In jump combination, may not repeat Axel or double Axel from (1) or double or triple jump from (2). Spin changed to camel or sit spin (minimum 6 revs), no change of foot permitted; may not have flying entry. In the spin combination, the minimum number of revs is 2 for each position. **One** step sequences of a different nature with full utilization of the ice surface (straight line, serpentine or circular).

Rule 3662: Novice Ladies Short Program (Technical Elements)

In jump combination, may not repeat Axel or double Axel from (1) or double or triple jump from (2). Layback or sideways leaning spin may not have a flying entry; no change of foot. In spin combination, the minimum number of revs required in a position is 2. **One** spiral sequence consisting of at least 2 spiral positions (held for at least 3 seconds).

Rule 3663: Novice Well-Balanced Free Skate Program Requirements

Spins: maximum of 3 spins of a different nature (one of which must be a flying spin) with a minimum of 5 revs and 1 a spin combination (minimum of 10 revs). The number of changes of foot in the spin combination is optional.

Remarks:

<u>B.</u> A total of two jumps with 2-1/2 or 3 revs may be repeated, and at least one attempt must be in a jump combination or jump sequence.

Rule 3663: Novice Well-Balanced Free Skate **Program Requirements (continued)** Remarks:

B. A total of two jumps with 2-1/2 or 3 revs may be repeated, and at least one attempt must be in a jump combination or jump sequence.

C. Spins: The required combination spin must have at least 1 change of position and at least 1 change of foot and may have a flying entry (minimum of 2 revs in position). The required minimum number of total revs is 10. The required flying spin may change feet and/or position; however, the landing position must be held for a minimum of 2 revs. The minimum number of revs for the flying spin is 6. All spins in this program may begin with a jump and may change feet. D. The step sequence or spiral sequence must utilize the entire ice surface. Additional moves in the field and spiral positions will be counted as transitions.

Rule 3681: Juvenile and Open Juvenile Well-**Balanced Free Skate Program Requirements**

D. Spins: The minimum number of revs for the flying spin is 5. The third spin element is the choice of the skater but must be held for at least 5 revs.

Rule 4110: Adult Master Pairs

Implementation of an adult championship pairs event, effective with the 2007 adult sectional and U.S. Adult Championships.

Rule 4231: Conduct of Compulsory Dance Events

Reduces the number of patterns of the European Waltz from three to two. Amends the starting point for the European Waltz and American Waltz. Changes will affect dance patterns in the Rulebook.

Rule 4241: Selection and Posting of Compulsory Dances

The selection and posting of compulsory dances for senior, junior, novice, intermediate, juvenile, prejuvenile and all adult dance events will be drawn and announced no later than the May Board of Directors meeting.

Test Rule 43.05: Compulsory Dance Requirements

Reduces the number of required test patterns from 3 to 2 for the following dances: Dutch Waltz, Canasta Tango, Rhythm Blues, Cha Cha, Fiesta Tango, Willow Waltz, Hickory Hoedown, and Ten Fox.

Test Rules 54.01 - 54.05: Juvenile - Senior and **Masters Free Dance Tests**

Added language and requirements.

Test Rules 30.01, 37.01, 53.51: Singles, Pairs, Dance

Reskating of any element of a test would be amended by the addition of item C that permits a skater or couple who have omitted a required element or substituted for a required element in the test to use one of their reskates to fulfill the stated requirement.

All rounds, novice - senior singles; all pairs, dance, and lower level events will use the 6.0 system

2006 - 2007 Sectional and U.S. Championships All events

2006 - 2007 U.S. Junior Championships All events

2006 - 2007 U.S. Adult Championships

Gold and above free skate events in singles, pairs and dance

2007 - 2008 Regional Championships

Juvenile and above events

Articles VII and IX: Withdrawn

Implementation of a Materials and Service Fee for delegates and observers attending Governing Council.

Rule 3141: Registration for U.S. Junior Figure **Skating Championships**

Reduce the minimum number of skaters advancing from regional to U.S. Junior Championships from four to two.

Judges Committee

Realign the competition judges structure as follows:

Singles, Pairs, Dance: Novice judges become regional judges

Singles, Pairs, Dance: Junior and senior judges become sectional judges

Synchronized Skating: Novice judges become junior sectional judges

Synchronized Skating: Junior and senior judges become senior sectional judges

SICSC Proposed Bylaws Amendments

The following are proposed amendments to the SICSC bylaws:

Article IV (Membership)

Delete Alabama, Tennessee, and North Carolina from the list of states from which clubs may participate in the SICSC. Rationale: Clubs in these states have formed their own interclub councils.

Article X (Dues)

Change the date by which dues must be paid to July 1 (to coincide with recommended fiscal year change (below).

Article XII

Change the fiscal year from October 1 - September 30 to July 1 - June 30 to coincide with U.S. Figure Skating's membership year.

Article XIV (Loss of Membership Privileges)

Change the late payment date from December 1 to September 1 to coincide with the fiscal year change.

U.S. Figure Skating, State Farm, and the Program Development Committee are now accepting applications for the 2007 State Farm Scholastic Honors Team. The Honors Team is a program designed to recognize high

school age U.S. Figure Skating members who have distinguished themselves both in figure skating and high school academics. The application and supporting materials must be completed and postmarked by September 15, 2006.

The criteria for consideration are as follows:

- Eligible skater and current member of U.S. Figure Skating
